

Chadds Ford was built in 1925. Additions have been added over the years with a full renovation in 2003.

CFE is equipped with a gym, a cafeteria, a library, 29 classrooms, a science lab, a computer lab, a health room, and a Makerspace.

We have 1 AM/PM K, 1 Pre-first, 3 sections of 1st and 2nd grade, 2 sections of 3rd grade, 4 sections of 4th grade and 3 sections of 5th grade.

Current student enrollment is 365.

CFES staff is comprised of 70 professionals.

### **History • Art • Tradition**



#### The May Fair:

Began in 1949 as a full day school fair that included a pet show, May Procession, Maypole dance, a full rodeo, softball games, a community sing, and a square dance.

Today, it still includes a traditional Maypole dance (3rd grade girls), as well as choral performances by all grades, and a parachute dance by 3rd grade boys.

The 71st annual May Fair will be held on Fri. May 8th 2020!

### Academics

- ★ We utilize the Math in Focus (Singapore) Mathematics curriculum in all grades
- ★ We utilize the WONDERS Reading Program for reading, writing, and spelling instruction.
  - We use an RTII model (grades 1-5) to provide targeted small group instruction.
- ★ We use a combination of STC and FOSS Kit-based Science programs. These programs focus on experiments and hands-on experiences.
- ★ We utilize a Pearson Social Studies program that includes guided reading books which allows us to differentiate readability and content.
- ★ We also use various supplemental programs to extend, remediate, and enrich our students.











## **Technology @ CFES**



- $\star$  We view technology as a tool for learning.
- ★ All students have "Technology" 1 day per cycle (6 days) in our Innovation Tech Lab. Computer class focuses on a great range of skills and applications. Students create using Garageband, iMovie, and Tinker (coding) just to name a few programs.
- ★ All teachers have a Smartboard, document camera, a laptop, and an iPad to use in the classroom at all times.
- $\star$  We currently maintain:
  - 8 Chromebook carts (25-30 Chromebooks per cart)
  - 3 iPad carts (25-30 iPads per cart)
  - Classroom iMac stations
- $\star$  Makerspace:
  - 2 Maker Lab classrooms
  - Mobile carts
  - 3D Printers
  - Robotics (Lego, Dash/Dot, Drones)
  - Project-based learning activities






