- **Review and Approve Budget:** Leigh Heister presented on the November expenditures/income:

Expenditures included: \$425 for accounting services, \$198 for assemblies, \$2,964.64 for PTO Enrichment grants, \$250 for community service projects, \$370.25 for Buddy Breakfast, \$300 for the FOCUS program, \$384.77 for the Read-A-Thon and \$345.72 for teacher grants.

Income included: \$9,841 from Book Fair, \$3,318 from Clubs, \$3.68 in interest income, \$175.43 in passive fundraising, \$575 from PTO membership, \$26.44 from Square One Art, \$8.15 from supply sales and 1,924.58 from yearbook sales last spring. The budget was approved with no opposition.

• Principal's Report: Mr. Dutkiewicz presented several updates:

(1) Thank you to PTO for last month's enrichment grants. Plans are to have the kids make a video showing what was purchased and how the grant requests are making a great impact.

(2) The Chinese Acrobat assembly was well received. The kids loved it.

(3) Visited Patton Middle School to see how their STEM and garden projects are working.

(4) Will be hiring a long term sub to replace Mrs. Hughes in 4th grade, who is out on maternity leave.

(5) Presented the UCFSD Achievement Report 2018. CFES is in the top 1% of elementary schools in the state and ranked 10th in the state on school digger.

(6) Silke Hansen is painting a new Growth Mindset mural outside the cafeteria. Planning is in place for more new projects for her as well.

(7) December 20th is the Makey Makey challenge for 4th and 5th grade. Students will rate the projects and kids will get a trophy made on the 3D printer.

(8) December 17th is an all-day CFE challenge across the grades to work together to find the missing mascot, Chadd.
